### Note:

COBSE (Counsel of Boards of School Education in India) grants membership to boards/Institutions that are set up by an Act of Parliament or State Legislature or by an Executive orders of the Central/State Government and broadly follow the National Curriculum Framework/CBSE. Therefore, candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from member-boards of COBSE are acceptable for admissions. A complete list of member-Boards of COBSE can be download from [www.cobse.org](http://www.cobse.org). Boards not in the list of member –Boards of COBSE shall not be acceptable for admissions. The Board of Management resolved that the list of Boards recognized by COBSE shall be considered for admission to higher courses run by the University.

## Important Instructions (PLEASE READ IN DETAIL)

1. Eligibility and qualifications will be as per Punjab Govt. Notification No.5/3/2011-3HBIII/3435 dated:28/05/2018. **Candidates must be NEET UG-2019 qualified.**
2. Distribution of seats will be as per Punjab Govt. Notification, the list of eligible colleges/seats may increase/decrease, subject to the orders of Hon'ble Courts/CCIM/CCH/Govt. The final list of seats will be displayed at the time of counselling.
3. **Correction(s) In Online Registration/Counselling** In case candidate want to make any change in his/her online form , he/she can do the same by logging on again in his/her online application form by using the password provided by the University on or before the last date for submission of form. Online Admission Application Form will be locked automatically after the cut-off date for submission of online admission application form. No request for any correction in admission application form will be considered thereafter. Filling more than one form for one candidate may cause cancelation of the candidature.
4. **Sports Category Candidates:-**The candidates who applied under Sports Category (Category Code 17), will submit printed/hard copy of online submitted form **personally (by hand)** in the allocated college along with Sports Gradation Certificate issued by the Director, Sports, Punjab and other supporting self attested copies of certificates/documents.
5. Candidates of category Backward Area (Category 14), Border Area (Category Code 15), Physically Handicapped (Category Code 16), Riot/terrorist affected (Category Codes- 18(1), 18(2), 19, 20(1), 20(2), 21) and Freedom Fighter (Category Code 31) **will report at allocated college along with original certificate** for physical verification of documents and checking of eligibility .
6. Candidates of categories wards of defence personnel (Category Code 22 to 26), wards of Punjab Police Personnel, Punjab Armed Police, Punjab Home Guards and Para-Military Forces (Category Codes-28 to 30) and Migrants from Jammu & Kashmir due to terrorist violence (Category Code 32) **will report at allocated college along with original certificate** for physical verification of documents and checking of eligibility.
7. Allocation of seat is provisional subject to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned Ayurvedic/Homoeopathy/Unani Colleges. It is sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of the provisionally allocated candidates before their joining/admission.
8. Correct category must be filled carefully in the online application form. No claim shall be allowed if category/categories are not indicated in online application form. Only those candidates who claim Reservation by filling categories code in online application form shall be considered for reserve seat.
9. After last date of submission of online Registration Form, no request will be entertained for any change therein.
10. Only registered candidates are eligible for the counselling(s) and without registration none of candidates are allowed for the counselling (online).
11. 15% of total seats of All India Quota shall be filled by Govt. of India, Whereas remaining 85% seats of Punjab Quota Shall be filled by Guru Ravidas Ayurved University, Hoshiarpur. In case 15% seats of All India Quota are not filled then Guru Ravidas Ayurved University, Hoshiarpur shall take decision to fill these remaining unfilled seats.

## INTRODUCTION

### BRIEF HISTORY:

Guru Ravidas Ayurved University Punjab, Hoshiarpur was created with the promulgation of the Guru Ravidas Ayurved University Punjab Act, 2009 (Punjab Act No. 4 of 2010) by the Punjab Legislative Assembly. This University regulates the conduct of both undergraduate and post-graduate Ayurvedic, Homeopathic and Unani teaching in 21 affiliated colleges in the State of Punjab. It has about 6,000 registered students presently undergoing undergraduate and postgraduate studies in various disciplines.

### UNIVERSITY'S PRESENT STATUS:

This University is one of its own kinds in North India. It is presently poised for a quantum leap in development and progress. The foundation stone of university campus was laid on 9. 10. 2011 by Sardar Parkash Singh Ji Badal, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Punjab and the administrative Block of University Campus in village Kharkan, Near Hoshiarpur and just 10 km from Hoshiarpur city was inaugurated by Sh Vijay Sampla, Hon'ble Minister of State, Social Justice and Social Welfare, Government of India on 19.04.2016 . It will bring about major development in AYUSH and all basic, clinical and allied departments to pursue on education and research. It will attract appropriate talent from all over the country to work in its faculties. It will shortly start new AYUSH courses.

### University Examination System:

The University had introduced e-transfer system of question papers of various courses to the examination centers to maintain the sanctity of examinations. This process and implementation strategies will help us to deliver, efficiency, reliability in high stakes examination and their certifications.

**IMPORTANT GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS  
(PLEASE READ IN DETAIL)**

1. Registration for admission to BAMS/BHMS/BUMS courses is to be undertaken online at the University website.
2. Application form for admission to BAMS/BHMS/BUMS courses can't be submitted offline/printed copy by post.
3. This prospectus contains two parts :
  - Part-A** Pertains to the general procedure for applying to admission, submission of admission application/counselling form, deposition of fee, important instructions, joining, etc.
  - Part-B** Pertains to Contains Punjab Govt. Notifications for admission to BAMS/BHMS/BUMS Courses proforma for different categories, self undertaking, etc.
- Note: Candidates can download the prospectus from University website.**
4. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as given in the Prospectus and University website. Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
5. Incomplete application not in accordance with instructions shall not be considered and are liable to be rejected. The fee shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
6. This prospectus is subject to alteration(s) / modification(s) at any time without notice. For updates please visit University website from time to time.
7. Instructions in this prospectus are liable to changes based on decision/s taken by the Punjab Government/University from time to time. There is no equity or any rights that are/or deemed to be arising in favour of candidate.
8. Admissions including Eligibility to BAMS/BHMS/BUMS Courses shall be governed and regulated as per the rules and regulations etc, as per Punjab Govt. notifications.
9. The candidate should read the eligibility condition carefully and just applying for admission/counselling does not entitle him/her for admission. Eligibility conditions for admissions are given in the Notification. The eligibility shall be determined by the Selection Committee/Principal of concerned college at the time of counseling/admission. Those who are not eligible as per Punjab Govt. notification will not be considered for admission. The candidates will participate in counselling process at their own risk & responsibility. Eligibility is also subject to medical fitness and such criteria as may be prescribed by the Punjab Government/ University/Medical institutions/ CCIM/CCH.
10. Candidates' eligibility is purely provisional & subject to the fulfillment of eligibility criteria as Punjab Government Notification incorporated in this prospectus.
11. Applications of candidates producing false or fabricated information shall not be considered and candidates shall be further debarred from participating in any Counseling's conducted by GRAU, Hoshiarpur.
12. Any attempt by a candidate to influence directly or indirectly any person concerned with the admission will disqualify him/her.
13. Final seat matrix shall be available on the university website at the time of filling options/preferences College/Quota/Category for online counseling.
14. The admission for BAMS/BHMS/BUMS courses shall be made only to those institutions which have permission from all of the concerned authorities and affiliated with the University.
15. The fee structure for the Government/Privately managed colleges is as per Punjab Government notification(s) for BAMS/BHMS/BUMS courses. If Punjab Government issues any subsequent amendment/corrigendum for change in fee structure, the same will be applicable in letter and spirit.
16. In case of any discrepancy or contradiction between the Government notification/s and The University instructions contained in this Prospectus, the letter and spirit of the notification/s shall be prevailing, however in academic matters the University shall be the final Authority.

17. Deposition of fee does not confirm the admission of the candidate, if it is challenged in the Hon'ble Court.
18. Changes, if any, in the Schedule / Counselling etc. shall be notified only through website of the University i.e. [www.graupunjab.org](http://www.graupunjab.org)
19. Candidates must retain the copy of prospectus with them till admissions. They should read carefully the instructions and the rules & regulations of the Punjab Govt. Notification/s and comply with all instructions therein strictly.
20. The allotment of College to the applicants for admission, shall be made as per merit determined on the basis of NEET-UG-2019 and the choice of the station opted by the candidate at the time of online counselling.
21. This is for the information of all candidates that as per Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/her from the institution.
22. First of all candidate will have read the Punjab Govt. notification/instructions as contained in the Prospectus carefully on university website [www.graupunjab.org](http://www.graupunjab.org) before filling online admission application form.
23. Candidates will fill only online admission application form through GRAU website i.e. [www.graupunjab.org](http://www.graupunjab.org). Candidates are advised to fill online admission application form before the due date. Online Admission application form will not be available on university website after the due date/time. Candidates are advised to fill the online admission application form well in advance to avoid the network congestion in the last days. GRAUH will not be responsible for network congestion/problems. No request for accepting the forms after cut-off date will be entertained.
24. State Merit list will be prepared for different categories in which candidate applies, on the basis of NEET(UG)-2019 ranking.
25. **Post Matric Scholarship Scheme:** Scheduled Caste/Backward Classes category candidates shall be eligible to apply for the Post-Matric Scholarship and reimbursement of fee if they fulfill the terms and conditions laid down by Department of Welfare, Govt. of Punjab. For details regarding this scheme/forms/procedure, respective colleges/candidates should visit the website of Punjab Govt., Deptt. of Medical Education and Research ([www.punjabmedicaleducation.org](http://www.punjabmedicaleducation.org)). For any query/clarification, candidates/respective colleges can contact the office of Director, Medical Education and Research, Punjab, Chandigarh or Director, Welfare Deptt., Punjab, Chandigarh. For further information and applying for scholarship candidates may visit <http://www.punjabships.gov.in>. It is also responsibility of the concerned candidate to ensure that college has filled his/her application for scholarship in time.
26. **Application Fee**
  - a) Admission Application Fee of Rs. 4600 (Rs.3750 for SC candidates) will only be deposited through Debit card/Credit Card/Netbanking after successful filling of online admission application form on university website.
  - b) Admission Application Fee will not be accepted in any form after due date/time in any case.
  - c) Only those Admission Application Forms will be considered for counselling, fee of which has been deposited by due date/time.
  - d) No request for accepting the Admission Application Forms after due date/time will be entertained.
  - e) Merely deposition of fee will not entitle the candidate for claim of admission.
  - f) Fee once deposited in University Account will not be refunded/adjusted in any case.
27. Notwithstanding the participation of candidates in counselling, only eligible candidates, as per Government notification/s, shall be considered for admission.

28. Candidates applying under any of the reserve category are directed to fill the right category code mentioned in this prospectus for claiming reservation under a category and also bring/upload all relevant documents/proof of respective category with admission application form and also directed to bring along photocopies and originals at the time of counseling/admission.
29. Instructions only for NRI Candidates:- Candidates who wants to apply under NRI quota seats, have to obtain provisional Eligibility/equivalency certificate from the GRAU, Hoshiarpur and will have to qualify NEET-UG-2019 and candidates will apply on prescribed Performa available on university website along with prescribed fee for NRI seats.
30. Annexure –I (Page no-44) & Annexure- V (Page no-68) **is compulsory for all the candidates** applying for admission.

- (iii) "BUMS" means Bachelor of Unani Medicine and Surgery.
- (iv) "GRAUP" means Guru Ravidas Ayurved University Punjab.
- (v) "Council" means the national statutory council regulating a particular discipline such as:-
  - 'CCIM' means Central Council of Indian Medicine.
  - 'CCH' means Central Council of Homoeopathy.
- (vi) "Eligible Candidate" means a candidate who satisfies the requirements of eligibility as prescribed in the Prospectus / Government Notification **and corrigendum issued from time to time and other notifications issued for this purpose from time to time** and the criteria of Guru Ravidas Ayurved University Punjab, Hoshiarpur.
- (vii) "Government Notification" means Notification **No.** No.5/3/2011-3HBIII/3435 dated:28/05/2018. **and corrigendum issued from time to time and other notifications issued for this purpose from time to time** by the Department of Medical Education & Research.
- (viii) "University" means Guru Ravidas Ayurved University Punjab, V.P.O Kharkan , Hoshiarpur.

**ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS**

1. The **admission to BAMS/BHMS/BUMS Courses** shall be open to candidates who have qualified NEET UG-2019 and eligible as per Punjab Govt. notifications and subsequent amendment(s)/corrigendum(s).
2. Merely applying for admission to **BAMS/BHMS/BUMS** courses on the basis of NEET-UG-2019 will not entitle the Candidates eligible, eligibility and Merit of a candidate for admission will be determined by the **Selection Committee** strictly as per rules and regulations laid down in the **Punjab Govt. Notification(s)** as published in this prospectus and all other such documents as are required with the **ADMISSION APPLICATION FORM**.
3. Counseling/Admissions shall be conducted by the **Admission/Selection Committee** constituted by the Punjab Government for this purpose.
4. Age as per NEET-UG 2019.

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**INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING UP ONLINE ADMISSION APPLICATION FORM**

1. Candidates will have to log on University website i.e. [www.graupunjab.org](http://www.graupunjab.org) and read the Punjab Govt. notification and instructions as contained in the Prospectus carefully.
2. NEET-UG-2019 qualified candidates are eligible to apply **ONLINE** for admission to BAMS/BHMS/BUMS Courses.
3. Candidates are required to register themselves for admission to BAMS/BHMS/BUMS Courses through online registration system at GRAU website i.e. [www.graupunjab.org](http://www.graupunjab.org). Online registration must be completed by due date and time.
4. Candidates are advised to fill the online admission application form well in advance to avoid the network congestion in the last days. GRAU will not be responsible for network congestion/problems. No request for accepting the forms after cut-off date will be entertained.
5. Following documents are required to upload on the online registration form:
  - I. Soft copy of Photograph of the candidate. (Maximum size 30 KB)
  - II. Soft copy of the signatures of the candidate. (Maximum Size 30 KB)
6. Specifications for Photograph:–
  - I. A colour photograph of minimum 35x45 mm with at least 75% coverage of face & head of the candidate.
  - II. A caption indicating name of candidate and date of taking photograph should be there at the bottom of photo.
  - III. Photograph should be taken in a white /very light colored background.
  - IV. Photograph should not have cap or goggles. Spectacles are allowed if being used regularly. POLAROID and COMPUTER generated photos are not acceptable.
  - V. The photograph needs to display full front view of the face. Please look directly into the camera with a neutral expression.
  - VI. Please avoid photograph with reflection or shadow on the face with red eyes.
  - VII. The photograph needs to be printed on a high quality paper with at least 600 dpi resolutions.
  - VIII. The colours must possess the natural appearance and skin tone.
  - IX. The photograph must not have kinks, scratches and stains.

**Note:** Applications not complying with these instructions or with unclear photographs are liable to be rejected.
7. After completion of filling online admission application form, University will issue a unique Registration ID (i.e. Login ID) and password will be provided to the candidate at his/her registered Mobile number in admission application form through SMS/ email. Registration Number and password are mandatory for further process, so keep it secret and don't disclose to any unknown person.
8. Merely submitting of online application form & fee does not confer any automatic rights to secure a BAMS/BHMS/BUMS seat.
9. Please visit GRAU, Hoshiarpur website [www.graupunjab.org](http://www.graupunjab.org) for all regular and updated information concerning admissions/Date of counselling from time to time.
10. No request for submitting online application after due date/time will be entertained on any ground.
11. Candidate shall fill online ADMISSION APPLICATION FORM only once. Applications submitted more than once are liable to be rejected.
12. Candidates are required to fill online admission application form very carefully and should not leave any column blank, fill '0' (zero) in case of Roll Number/Rank/Marks are not available.
13. **Depositing Fee:** - After filling of successful online admission application form, Candidates will have to deposit the fee through payment gateway using Debit Card/Credit card/Net Banking .
14. Take printout of the online filled admission application form.
15. **Fill category(ies) carefully in the online admission application form. Category(ies) once claimed will not be changed in any case after submitting the form.**

Those candidates, who will not fill/claim any category code as per prospectus or wrongly filled category code other than mentioned in prospectus, will be treated as Open/General Category candidate. The candidate may select a category code from the codes given below and fill the category accordingly. More than one category may be filled by a candidate if it is considered

applicable in the candidate's particular case. Category codes are exclusively for the purpose of facilitating the candidates to know and understand his/her respective merit placement at the time of counselling in various reserved categories as might have been filled by him/her. Reserve category selection on the part of the candidate shall not in any case be construed to give him/her any legitimacy or right or claim on the benefits for reserved seats during admission. Claims to admissions against reserved seats in BAMS/BHMS/BUMS courses will be on the basis of appropriate claims made in the Admission Application Form subject to rules and regulations contained in the Punjab Government Notifications printed in the Part-B of this prospectus and as per the decisions of the Selection Committee constituted for this purpose by the Punjab Government. No benefit of reservation whatsoever shall be given if the claim is not made in Admission Application Form.

**STEPS FOR ONLINE COUNSELLING :-**

1. NEET-2019 qualified candidates shall visit University website i.e. [www.graupunjab.org](http://www.graupunjab.org) and fill the online registration form carefully within stipulated date & time. After successful registration of the applicant, a unique Registration ID (i.e. Login ID) and password will be allotted to the candidate at his/her registered mobile no. or email through SMS or by email. Registration ID and password are mandatory for further process, so keep it secret and don't disclose to any unknown person.
2. The candidate has to deposit the requisite fee through Payment Gateway using Debit Card/Credit Card/Net Banking.
3. **Only registered candidates are eligible for the counselling(s) and without registration none of candidates are allowed for the counselling (online/physical).**
4. In the online application form candidate shall carefully fill the particulars viz; Name/F'Name/Preference of course / College/Category/Quota/NEET-2019 Marks, etc.
5. Candidates can fill their institutional preferences for getting their seats in the 1<sup>st</sup> round of counselling.
6. The seat will be allotted to the candidate as per merit list and institutional preferences filled by him/her in the online application form. The candidate has to report to his/her respective college for checking of eligibility, document verification and medical checkup. The candidates are required to produce his/her original documents/credentials for verification.
7. After the verification of the documents and checking of eligibility, the concerned Principal of the College shall issue bank challan for fee deposition and the candidate has to deposit the fee in the bank as per the challan form.

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR COUNSELLING

1. Online counselling will be held through University Website and online counselling form will be made available on university website as per dates specified in Important Dates.
2. In case of physical counselling, personal appearance of candidates is essential at the time of interview/counseling and exemptions from personal appearance may not be sought as it shall not be granted.
3. The candidates should read the eligibility conditions carefully and just exercising online option of college/ appearing in counselling does not entitle him/her for admission.
4. Eligibility conditions for admissions are as per Punjab Govt. Notification(s). The eligibility shall be determined by the Selection Committee at the time of counseling. Those who are not eligible as per Punjab Govt. notification will not be considered for admission. The candidates will appear in counselling at their own risk & responsibility.
5. The allotment of seat and college shall be made as per the choice of the candidate at the time of the counselling by the Admission Committee on the basis of the merit determined as per marks obtained by the candidate in NEET-UG-2019 and other terms and conditions contained in the Punjab Government Notification for admission to BAMS/BHMS/BUMS Courses.
6. The candidates shall have to produce all the certificates/degrees/diplomas/ documents in original at the time of joining/admission in respective colleges or at the time of physical counseling.
7. The choice(s) of courses/ institutions shall be exercised by the candidate at the time of Counseling/ interview.
8. **Checking/Verification of Original Certificate/Documents** :Allocation of seat is provisional subject to verification of original documents/checking of eligibility by the Principal of concerned Ayurvedic/Homoeopathy/Unani Colleges. After provisional allocation of seat, candidate shall have to report to the allocated college for getting challan form, verification of documents and checking of eligibility. It is sole responsibility of the Principal to authenticate the eligibility of the provisionally allocated candidate before their joining/admission.
9. **Deposition of Annual Fee after provisional allocation** : Candidate will deposit tuition fee (as per Punjab Govt. notification) through specified bank challan form to be issued by the Principal of the concerned college. Candidate will report for medical checkup and joining after submission of proof of fee deposition to the respective college within stipulated time period, failing which allocated seat will stand cancelled automatically without any intimation to the candidate.  
In case of physical counselling candidate will have to deposit tuition fee as specified in the Punjab Govt. notification on the spot at the venue of counselling in the shape of Demand Draft in favour of "Registrar, Guru Ravidas Ayurved University " payable at "Hoshiarpur" failing which his/her provisional selection will be treated as cancelled without any intimation to the candidate.

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## PROCEDURE OF ONLINE COUNSELLING AND JOINING AT THE COLLEGES

Counselling for admission to BAMS/BHMS/BUMS course NEET-UG-2019 will be online and then Physical counselling round. During online counselling, candidates will fill online counselling form therein they will give their preferences of course, college, category, quota. Seat will be allocated as per the merit of NEET-UG – 2019 and order of preferences given by the candidate. Therefore, candidates are advised to take care during filling up the order of preferences of course, college, category, quota. Candidates of reserved categories will also be considered in open merit, if open merit seat is available then seat of open merit will be allocated to them else seat of reserved category will be allocated.

There will be one round of online counselling and subsequent round of physical counselling. After provisionally allocation of seat, candidates can download provisional allocation letter from the University website after login to their account and report to the respective college along with all original documents for the checking of documents and their eligibility. **After checking of their original documents and eligibility, Principal of the respective college will issue a bank challan for deposition of tuition fee at any branch of Axis Bank** After depositing tuition fee, candidates will again report at the provisionally allocated college for their joining and medical checkup. If any candidates do not follow the said process his/her allocated seat will be cancelled automatically without any intimation.

If candidate is satisfied with seat allocated to him/her during online counselling, he/she is not required to participate in the subsequent round of counsellings. **In case, candidate wants to upgrade/change his/her seat he/she will have to participate in the subsequent round of counselling and give their preferences afresh for the course/college/category/quota.**

In case any candidate wants to quit the course/seat, he/she will have to submit application to the respective college regarding their surrender of seat well in advance before start of next round of counselling.

In case candidate seat is upgraded/changed in the subsequent round of counselling and he/she has already deposited the tuition fee, he/she is not required to deposit fee again, provided he/she has to deposit any difference in fee, if any.

SITUATED IN THE STATE OF PUNJAB - 2018 and ONWARDS.

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1. The Government of Punjab is pleased to notify the admission criteria to Undergraduate Degree courses i.e. BAMS, BHMS and BUMS for the year 2018 onwards in the Government & Private Ayurvedic, Homoeopathic and Unani Institutes in the State of Punjab.
2. All admission to Govt. Quota seats/Management Quota seats, including NRI and any other seats, whatsoever in the Government & Private Ayurvedic/Homoeopathic/Unani institutes, shall be based on the merit of National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET) to be conducted by Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).
3. The Government of Punjab is further pleased to authorize Guru Ravidas Ayurved University, Hoshiarpur to conduct centralized counselling for admission to BAMS/BHMS/BUMS on the basis of marks obtained in NEET.
4. After the declaration of NEET result, the candidates shall apply on the specific proforma for all seats to Guru Ravidas Ayurved University, Hoshiarpur. Admission shall be made by the Admission Committee through a Centralized Counseling to be conducted by Guru Ravidas Ayurved University, Hoshiarpur on the basis of inter-se-merit of NEET. Fee and other charges for submission of application and counseling to be charged by the University shall be Rs. 3750/- for SC/ST candidates and Rs. 4600/- for all other candidates.
5. The Schedule of counseling, admission and start of classes shall be in conformity with the schedule laid down by Govt. of India, Ministry of AYUSH/State Govt. and shall be notified on the website of Guru Ravidas Ayurved University, Hoshiarpur i.e. [www.graupunjab.org](http://www.graupunjab.org).
6. The detail of the Institutions and category wise seats matrix shall be available on the website of Guru Ravidas Ayurved University, Hoshiarpur before the commencement of the counselling process.
7. Out of total seats 85% will be for candidates from Punjab State, whereas the remaining 15% seats will be open for candidates from any other state/UT of India.
8. A candidate from reserved Category shall have the right to compete for admission in General/Unreserved category seats as per his/her merit on

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the day of counselling and candidate so selected shall not be counted towards admission in the reserve category.

9. For seats under Punjab quota, the candidate should be a bonafide resident of Punjab. The resident status of Punjab state shall be taken in terms of Punjab Government, Department of Personnel and Administrative reforms (PP-II Branch) letter No. 1/3/95-3 PP II/9619, dated 6<sup>th</sup> June, 1996, ID No. 1/2/96-3PP-2/8976, dated 7<sup>th</sup> July, 1998 and ID No. 1/3/95-3PP/II/81, dated 1<sup>st</sup> January 1999 and any further instructions issued by the Department of Personnel, if any, and the same shall be adhered to. Candidate must have passed 10+1 and 10+2 examination from Punjab. Candidate who passed his/her 10+1 and 10+2 examinations or other equivalent examination from a recognized School/Institution situated in Chandigarh (Union Territory), who is bonafide resident of Punjab shall also be eligible.

**The following categories shall be exempted from this condition:-**

- i) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those regular Punjab Government employees, members of All India Services borne on Punjab cadre, Serving Judges and the employees of the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, employees of Boards/Corporations/Statutory Bodies established by an Act of the State of Punjab who have been holding posts outside Punjab on or before 1st January of the year of passing 10+2 examination and their children/wards/dependants have passed class XI and/or XII examinations from outside Punjab.
- ii) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those regular Central Government employees, employees of Boards/Corporations/Statutory Bodies of the Central Government who have remained posted inside Punjab for at least two years out of the three years preceding year of passing 10+2 examination but were posted outside Punjab for some time during these three years due to which their children/wards/dependants have passed class XI and/or XII or equivalent qualifying examinations from outside Punjab. However those who remained posted in Punjab continuously for these three years shall not be entitled to be exempted as they are equally placed with other Punjab Government employees posted in Punjab.
- iii) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of all those Punjab Government pensioners who have retired on or before 1st January of the year of passing 10+2 examination and have settled outside Punjab on or before 1st January of the year of passing 10+2 examination and their children/wards/dependants have passed class XII examination from outside Punjab.
- iv) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of those military/ para-military forces personnel who are born or belong to the State of Punjab as per their service record at the time of entry into service.
- v) Children/wards/dependents (whose parents are not alive) of those Ex-employees of military/ Para military forces who are born or belong to State of Punjab as per their service record at the time of entry into the



service and have retired on or after 1st January of the year preceding two years of the year of passing 10+2 examination.

- vi) Candidates belonging to minority community who are competing for the minority quota in the minority institutions.
- vii) Candidates seeking admission under NRI category.
- viii) Wards of defence personnel posted in Punjab.

Provided however, that in case adequate number of candidates from Punjab are not available for BAMS/BHMS/BUMS course, then other States candidates may be considered for admission in Punjab quota, strictly as per NEET merit.

*In view of the judgment dated 02.07.2014 in CWP No. 6009 of 2014 and connected cases by the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, the eligibility criteria from academic session 2019-2020 onwards shall be, inter-alia as under:-*

*"The candidate shall have passed his/her 10th Class examination and also 10+1 and 10+2 from the State of Punjab."*

#### 11. A) Reservation in Government Ayurvedic College :

The reservation for the State quota seats in Government Institute in various categories for admission to the Undergraduate courses in Government Ayurvedic Institute shall be as under:

- (i) Scheduled Castes 25%



(ii)	Backward Classes	10%
(iii)	Backward Area/ Border Area (1% each)	2%
(iv)	Physically Disabled	5%
(v)	Sports Persons	1%

Credit shall be given only for the sports achievements made during class XI and XII. The admission shall be made on the basis of inter-se merit of the candidates determined on the basis of gradation (Category A/B/C) issued by the Director of Sports, Punjab. However, for exempted categories under para 12 of this Notification, the competent authority will be Director, Sports of that State or U.T. from where the candidate has passed his class XI and XII examinations.

(vi)	Children/Grandchildren of terrorist affected persons	1%
	Children/Grandchildren of Sikh riot affected persons	1%

(In order of preference to the exclusion of next category) (Preference shall be given to a candidate whose parent or guardian is killed in such situation - Guardian to be considered only in case neither parent was alive at the relevant time)

- a. Persons killed in terrorist actions in Punjab/ riots outside Punjab.
- b. Terrorist/ Riot affected /displaced persons

(vii)	Wards of Defence Personnel	1%
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(In order of preference to the exclusion of next category)

- (a) Killed in action.
- (b) Disabled in action to the extent of 50% or above & Boarded out of service.
- (c) Died while in service & Death attributed to Military service.
- (d) Disabled in service & boarded out with disability attributed to Military Service.
- (e) Gallantry award/other award winners both serving/retired.
- (f) Serving defence personnel/ex-serviceman.

**Note:-** Certificate to this effect must be issued by Army/Navy/ Air Force Headquarters or the Commanding Officer of the Unit, countersigned by the Director, Defence Services Welfare, Punjab in case of the Serving Defence Personnel. In case of Ex-Servicemen certificate should be signed by the concerned District Defence Services Welfare Officer, countersigned by the Director, Defence Services Welfare, Punjab.

(viii)	Wards of Punjab Police Personnel, Punjab Armed Police, Punjab Home Guards and Para-Military Forces (in order of preference to the exclusion of next category)	1%.
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Certificate to this effect issued by Inspector General of Police (HQ), Punjab Police shall have to be produced while submitting other documents. In case of Paramilitary Forces this certificate shall be countersigned by IG Police (HQ) Punjab.

- (a) Killed in action

- (b) Disabled in action to the extent of 50%
- (c) Winners of President's Police Medal for Gallantry or Police Medal for Gallantry
- (ix) Children/grandchildren of freedom fighters of Punjab 1%

**b) Admission to Private Institutes**

- i) The distribution of seats in Private Ayurvedic Institutions shall be:

Government quota seats	50%
Management/Minority quota seats	50% (including 15% NRI quota)

- ii) **Reservation in Private Institutes** (for Government/Management quota seats) shall be as under:

a) Scheduled Caste	25%
b) Backward Classes	10%
c) Physically Disabled	5%
d) Migrants from Jammu & Kashmir due to terrorist violence.	1%

**Note:** Distributions of seats under Management / Minority quota for Admissions to Minority Institutes shall be as fixed by the respective Institutions in accordance with applicable laws.

**12. Non-Resident Indian (NRI) SEATS**

15% seats in all Private Institutes shall be earmarked for the Non-Resident Indians in the following order:

Category I: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to the State of Punjab.

Category II: NRI/Children of NRI who originally belong to an Indian State other than Punjab.

- I) Under this policy Non Resident Indian means a person of Indian origin, whether holding an Indian Passport or Foreign Passport, who is either permanently or temporarily settled outside India and in either case:

- (i) for or on taking up employment outside India ; or
- (ii) for carrying on a business or vocation outside India; or
- (iii) for any other purpose, in such circumstances, as would indicate his intention to stay outside India for an uncertain period;

For ascertaining the eligibility relevant documents including Foreign Country Passport or Green Card or Permanent Resident Card or Proof of Residency of Foreign country issued by competent authority or OCI/PIO Card issued by the Government of India shall be taken into consideration.

- II) The eligibility of the candidates shall be determined by the Guru Ravidas Ayurvedic University, Hoshiarpur who shall issue an eligibility certificate to each such candidate.



- III) The NRI students shall have to give a bank guarantee/surety bond for the balance of fee, if they opt to pay the fee in installments as provided.
- IV) The Centralized Counselling of NRI quota seats shall be held before the Counselling for other categories. In case of any seat remaining vacant under NRI quota, during / after 2nd Centralized Counselling of NRI quota in State Colleges, it shall go to General category and in the Private Colleges shall go to General Category of the Management quota. The NRI left over seats shall be filled by the same Admission Committee from amongst the eligible candidates of NEET.

13. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO BAMS / BHMS / BUMS COURSES:**

i) **FOR BAMS**

12<sup>th</sup> Standard with science or any other equivalent examination recognized by concerned State Governments and education boards, provided the candidates passes the examinations with 50% aggregate marks in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

ii) **FOR BHMS**

- i) No Candidate shall be admitted to B.H.M.S Degree Course unless he has passed:-

- (a) The higher secondary examination or the Indian School Certificate Examination which is equivalent to 10+2 Higher Secondary Examination after a period of 12 years study, the last two years of study comprising of Physics, Chemistry and Biology with Mathematics or any other elective subjects with English at a level not less than core course of English as prescribed by the National Council of Educational Research and Training after the introduction of the 10+2+3 years education structure as recommended by the National Committee on Education;

OR

- (b) The intermediate examination in Science of an Indian University/Board or other recognized examining body with Physics, Chemistry and Biology which shall include a practical test in these subjects and also English as a compulsory subject;

OR

- (c) The Pre-professional/pre-medical examination with Physics, Chemistry and Biology, after passing either the higher secondary school examination or the pre-university or an equivalent examination, or the pre-University or an equivalent Examination, which shall include a practical test in Physics, Chemistry and Biology and also English as compulsory subject;

OR

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- (d) The first year of the three year degree course of a recognized university with Physics, Chemistry and Biology including a practical test in these subjects provided the examination is a "University Examination" and candidate has passed 10+2 with the English at a level not less than a core course;

OR

- (e) Any other examination which, in scope and standard is found to be equivalent to the intermediate Science examination of an Indian University/Board, taking Physics, Chemistry and Biology including a practical test in each of these subjects and English and English as a compulsory Subject

- ii) No candidate shall be admitted to B.H.M.S Degree Course unless he has attained the age of 17 years on or before 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of his admission to the first year of course
- iii) No candidate shall be admitted to B.H.M.S Degree Course if he is blind (including colour blindness), deaf, dumb, deaf and dumb.

**iii) FOR BUMS**

Eligibility for admission to Kamil E-Tib-Wa-Jarahat course: To seek admission in respective course of Bachelor of Unani Medicine are as under: -

- (i) **Admission to Kamil-E-Tib.O -Jarajat Course:-** A candidate seeking admission to main Kamil-E-Tib.O -Jarajat (Bachelor of Unani Medicine and Surgery-BUMS) course must have passed:-

- (a) Intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent examination with at least fifty percent. Aggregate marks in the subjects of physics, Chemistry and Biology and the candidate shall have passed 10<sup>th</sup> standard with Urdu or Arabic or Persian language as a subject, or clear the test of Urdu of 10<sup>th</sup> standard (wherever there is provision to conduct of such test) in the entrance examination conducted by the University or Board or registered Society or Associations authorized by the Government to conduct such examination:

- (b).The pre-Tib of one examination of one-year duration.\*

*\* Admission may be made on a maximum of ten seats per year out of the total number of intake capacity permitted Kamile Tib O Jarajat (Bachelor of Unani Medicine and Surgery-B.U.M.S) to main course through Pre-Tib course.*

**14. PROCEDURE FOR FILLING LEFT OVER SEATS:-**

For all the left over seats the counselling shall be held at University level, by the same Admission Committee with the same merit as that of NEET. No fresh applications shall be called and no admission shall be done by individual institutions under any circumstances.

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**15. APPELLATE AUTHORITY:-**

Director, Research and Medical Education, Punjab, shall be the appellate authority in case of any dispute.

**16. FEE**

(a) Fee for admission to various courses in Government Institutes will be as notified by the State Government.

(b) Fees (Annual) Private Institutes (BAMS/BUMS)

The fee for private institutions will be as per Govt. Notification no. 5/3/2010/3 /559 dated 21.01.2011 and is as given below:-

Govt. Quota Seats	80,000/- INR per Annum
Management Quota Seats	1,20,000/- INR per Annum

(iii) Fees (Annual) Private Institutes (BHMS)\*

For all types of Seats 1,28,870/- INR per Annum (2018-19)

*\* The annual & full course fee for students admitted in the subsequent academic session (i.e. 2018-19 onwards) shall be 10% higher than fee charged to the students admitted in the previous session.*

In addition to above each student will have to pay a Security Advance of Rs. 25000/- or its equivalent (refundable) at the time of his/her admission, along with the course fee.

**(c) Fee for NRI Quota seats will be notified separately.**

**Note :**

- (i) Fee will be deposited by the successful candidates to the respective institute in the shape of Bank Draft in the name of Registrar, Guru Ravidas Ayurved University, Hoshiarpur.
- (ii) The above fee include all kinds of charges and nothing extra will be charged from the students by the concerned institutes, under any circumstances on any account whatsoever.
- (iii) The fee will be payable on six monthly basis and the institutes shall not insist on the candidate to deposit fee of the entire course in advance.
- (iv) If candidate is shifted from one College to another in the subsequent Counselling, the fee shall be refunded / adjusted after completion of the admission process. The University shall refund / adjust the fee within 45 days.
- (v) Fee for NRI unfilled seats under management shall not exceed double than management quota fee or NRI quota fee whichever is lower.

**17. HOSTEL FEE**

Hostel fee and security advance (Annual and provisional) for private institutes.

- i) Non Air Conditioned Independent Room: Rs.15,000/- per year for the First year (Maximum) for single bedroom. This fee may be hiked by maximum upto 5% for each subsequent year.
- ii) Special Room (Attached bathroom and AC) : Rs.24,000/- per year (Maximum). This fee may be hiked by maximum upto 10% for each subsequent year.
- iii) Security Advance Rs. 25,000/- or its equivalent (refundable in the shape of demand draft.)
- iv) Mess charges- Actual and to be managed by the students.
- v) These charges are exclusive of electricity and water charges but inclusive of every other charge. All charges shall be levied from students on six monthly basis.
- vi) The Hostel fee and security deposit shall be refunded/ adjusted the concerned institute if candidate is shifted from one college to another in the subsequent counselling on operation of the waiting list. If the said fee is not refunded/adjusted within 15 days, the said Institution will be liable to pay Bank Interest as well as penal interest to the said students as laid by R.B.I.
- vii) No Institute shall insist upon the student to take the hostel facility compulsorily. It will be the sole discretion of the student whether to avail the hostel facility or not.

**18. DECLARATION TO BE SUBMITTED BY THE CANDIDATE**

The Candidate and his parent / guardian shall submit a sworn declaration that the candidate has not passed the qualifying examination from more than one Board / University and has not obtained admission in BAMS/BHMS/BUMS course in any other State / UT, except under All India Quota Seats.

**19. CANDIDATES ALREADY ADMITTED:-**

Any candidate, who has taken admission in the previous session in BAMS/BHMS/BUMS course, shall be eligible to seek admission again in the same course, like a fresh applicant based on marks of NEET if permitted by Central Council of Indian Medicine/ Central Council of Homoeopathy

**20. GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- i) The University shall display combined merit list of all candidates including reserve category and also a separate merit list of different categories which should be displayed on the University website at least 3 days before the counselling.
- ii) The admission shall be made to only those institutes which are approved from all the concerned authorities on or before the first counselling. Institute(s) which has applied for affiliation and/or for approval of competent authority(ies) but are unable to get affiliation and such approval from all the concerned authorities before this day shall not be considered for counselling. However these institutes may be included in subsequent counseling,
- iii) The last cut off date for admission to BAMS/BHMS/BUMS as per notification of Govt. of India/Ministry of Ayush.



- iv) In case of candidates whose parents are not alive, the dependency certificate shall have to be taken from the Deputy Commissioner / District Collector of the District or any other Government official duly authorized by the State Government or Deputy Commissioner / District Collector where the candidate resides.
  - v) Students claiming benefits of reservation under SC/BC category shall be required to produce a certificate from the competent authority as per latest instructions of Govt. of Punjab. Further, a valid Backward Class Certificate must be produced as per the latest instructions of Department of Welfare, Government of Punjab in which the annual income of the family is clearly mentioned.
  - vi) Scheduled Caste/ Backward Classes category candidates shall be eligible to apply for Post-Matric Scholarship and reimbursement of fee if they fulfill the terms and conditions laid down by Department of Welfare, Govt. of Punjab.
  - vii) The Reservation of Physically disabled persons shall be as per the provision of Right of Persons with Disability Act 2016.
  - viii) Seats remaining vacant under any of the reserve / minority category shall be transferred to the General Category.
  - ix) For students admitted through online counseling, fee shall be deposited as prescribed by Guru Ravidas Ayurved University, Hoshiarpur after verification of documents. For students admitted through physical counseling, fee shall be deposited through Bank Demand Draft only.
21. The State Government reserves the right to amend any clause and procedure for admission.
22. In case of any doubt, the Administrative Secretary, Department of Medical Education & Research, Government of Punjab may issue clarification which will have force of the policy.
23. This notification supersedes all the notifications for admission to BAMS/BHMS/BUMS courses in the State, issued earlier.

Please refer to the Ministry's letters of even number dated 12-2-2018 and 5-6-2018, wherein the Ministry has instructed all State/ UT Governments and concerned Universities to admit students in AYUSH Under Graduate Courses from the Academic Year 2018-19, only on the basis of the merit list of National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) conducted by CBSE in accordance to the existing rules and reservation policies of the concerned State Government.

2. In this regard, it has come to the notice of the Central Government that some of the States have issued notification for Counselling regarding admission in AYUSH UG courses not fully adopting the NEET notification/ Information Bulletin regarding the merit list and qualifying criteria.
3. In this context, it is further clarified that the intention of the Ministry in directing the concerned authorities to adopt the merit list of NEET includes adopting NEET notification as a whole including the "Merit list and qualifying Criteria" of the NEET information bulletin issued by CBSE. In the said NEET notification, it has been mentioned that in order to be eligible for admission for a particular academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in NEET for the said academic year. However, in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled castes, Scheduled tribes, Other Backward castes, the minimum marks shall be at 40<sup>th</sup> percentile. In respect of the candidates with bench marked Disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, the minimum marks shall be at 45<sup>th</sup> percentile for General category candidates and 40<sup>th</sup> percentile for SC/ST/OBC candidates. The percentile shall be determined on the basis of highest marks secured in the All India common merit list in NEET.
4. In view of above, all the concerns are requested for strict compliance of the above clarifications and to ensure that admission of students in AYUSH-UG Courses shall be mandatorily through merit list and qualifying criteria of NEET from the A.Y. 2018-19.

Therefore, all admissions in AYUSH UG courses shall be mandatorily through the merit list of National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (UG)- 2019 [NEET (UG)- 2019] and all admissions in ASU&H PG courses shall be mandatorily through the merit list of All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test-2019 (AIA-PGET-2019) for the academic year 2019-20. Further, the following provisions have been notified in above mentioned regulations.

a. The seat matrix for admission in the Government, Government-aided Institutions and Private Institutions shall be fifteen per cent. for the all India quota and eighty-five per cent. for the States and Union territories quota. This is applicable for both UG & PG seats of AYUSH systems.

b. The designated authority for counseling for all admissions to under-graduate and post graduate courses in all ASU & H educational institutions in the States and Union territories including institutions established by the State Government, University, Deemed University, Trust, Society, Minority Institution, Corporation or Company shall be the respective State or Union territory in accordance with the relevant rules and regulations of the concerned State or Union territory Government, as the case may be.

c. The counseling for all admission to B.A.M.S/B.U.M.S/B.S.M.S./B.H.M.S. and all AYUSH PG courses, for seats under all India quota as well as for all Ayurveda educational institutions established by the Central Government shall be conducted by the authority designated by the Central Government.





#### CENTRAL COUNCIL OF INDIAN MEDICINE

##### NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 7th December, 2018

**F. No. 24-14/2018 (UG Regulation).**—In exercise of the powers conferred by clauses (i), (j) and (k) of sub-section (1) of section 36 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970), the Central Council of Indian Medicine, with the previous sanction of the Central Government, hereby makes the following regulations further to amend the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Regulations, 1986, namely:—

1. **Short title, commencement and application.**—(1) These regulations may be called the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2018.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

(3) These regulations shall apply to students who shall be admitted for B.A.M.S., B.S.M.S. and B.U.M.S from the commencement of the academic session (2019-2020).

2. In the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Regulations, 1986 (hereinafter referred to as the said regulations) in Schedule-I, for regulation 2, the following regulation shall be substituted, namely:—

**“2. Eligibility for Admission.**— The eligibility to seek admission in Bachelor of Ayurveda education shall be as under:—

(a) The candidate must have passed intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent examination recognised by the concerned State Government and Education Board with the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and must have obtained minimum of fifty per cent. marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the aforesaid qualifying examination in the case of general category and forty per cent. Marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

(b) In respect of persons with disability candidate specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum qualifying marks in the said qualifying examination in Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be forty-five per cent. in the case of general category and forty per cent. in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

(c) No candidate shall be admitted to B.A.M.S Degree Course unless he has attained the age of seventeen years on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of his admission in the first year of the course and not more than of twenty-five years on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of admission in the first year of the course:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed by five years in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and physically handicapped candidates.

(d) (i) There shall be a uniform entrance examination for all medical institutions at the under-graduate level, namely the National Eligibility Entrance Test (NEET) for admission to under-graduate course in each academic year and shall be conducted by an authority designated by the Central Government.

(ii) In order to be eligible for admission to under-graduate course for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in the 'National Eligibility Entrance Test for under-graduate course' held for the said academic year:

Provided that in respect of-

(A) candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40<sup>th</sup> percentile;

(B) candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45<sup>th</sup> percentile in the case of general category and 40<sup>th</sup> percentile in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

*Explanation.*—The percentile shall be determined on the basis of highest marks secured in the all India common merit list in the National Eligibility Entrance Test for under-graduate courses:

Provided further that when sufficient number of candidates in the respective categories fail to secure minimum marks in the National Eligibility Entrance Test, as specified above, held for any academic year for admission to under-graduate courses, the Central Government in consultation with the Central Council may at its discretion lower the minimum marks required for admission to under-graduate course for candidates belonging to respective categories and marks so lowered by the Central Government shall be applicable for that academic year only.

(iii) An all India common merit list as well as State-wise merit list of the eligible candidates shall be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the National Eligibility Entrance Test and the candidates, within the respective categories, shall be admitted to under-graduate course from the said merit lists only.

(iv) The seat matrix for admission in the Government, Government-aided Institutions and Private Institutions shall be fifteen per cent. for the all India quota and eighty-five per cent. for the States and Union territories quota.

(v) The designated authority for counseling for all admissions to under-graduate course in all Ayurveda educational institutions in the States and Union territories including institutions established by the State Government, University, Deemed University, Trust, Society, Minority Institution, Corporation or Company shall be the respective State or Union territory in accordance with the relevant rules and regulations of the concerned State or Union territory Government, as the case may be.

(vi) The counseling for all admission to B.A.M.S Course for seats under all India quota as well as for all Ayurveda educational institutions established by the Central Government shall be conducted by the authority designated by the Central Government.

(vii) No candidate who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks as specified above shall be admitted to under-graduate course in the said academic year.

(viii) No authority or institution shall admit any candidate to the under-graduate course in contravention of the criteria or procedure as laid down by these regulations in respect of admissions and any candidate admitted in contravention of the said criteria or procedure shall be discharged by the Central Council forthwith.

(ix) The authority or institution which grants admission to any student in contravention of the aforesaid criteria or procedure shall be liable to face action in terms of the provisions of the Act.

(e) For foreign national candidate any other equivalent qualification to be approved by the Central Government may be allowed and clause (d) shall not be applicable for said foreign national candidate.”.



3. In the said regulations, in Schedule-II, for regulation 2, the following regulation shall be substituted, namely:—

**“2. Eligibility for admission.-** The eligibility to seek admission in Bachelor of Siddha education shall be as under:—

(a) The candidate must have passed intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent examination recognised by the concerned State Government and Education Board with the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and must have obtained minimum fifty per cent. marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the aforesaid qualifying examination in the case of general category and forty per cent. marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

(b) In respect of persons with disability candidate specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum qualifying marks in the said qualifying examination in Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be forty-five per cent. in the case of general category and forty per cent. in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

(c) No candidate shall be admitted to B.S.M.S Degree Course unless he has attained the age of seventeen years on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of his admission in the first year of the course and not more than of twenty-five years on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of admission in the first year of the course;

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed by five years in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and physically handicapped candidates.

(d) (i) There shall be a uniform entrance examination for all medical institutions at the under-graduate level, namely the National Eligibility Entrance Test (NEET) for admission to under-graduate course in each academic year and shall be conducted by an authority designated by the Central Government.

(ii) In order to be eligible for admission to under-graduate course for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in the 'National Eligibility Entrance Test for under-graduate course' held for the said academic year:

Provided that in respect of-

(A) candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40<sup>th</sup> percentile;

(B) candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45<sup>th</sup> percentile in the case of general category and 40<sup>th</sup> percentile in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

*Explanation.*—The percentile shall be determined on the basis of highest marks secured in the all India common merit list in the National Eligibility Entrance Test for under-graduate courses:

Provided further that when sufficient number of candidates in the respective categories fail to secure minimum marks in the National Eligibility Entrance Test, as specified above, held for any academic year for admission to under-graduate courses, the Central Government in consultation with the Central Council may at its discretion lower the minimum marks required for admission to under-graduate course for candidates belonging to respective categories and marks so lowered by the Central Government shall be applicable for that academic year only.

(iii) An all India common merit list as well as State-wise merit list of the eligible candidates shall be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the National Eligibility Entrance Test and the candidates, within the respective categories, shall be admitted to under-graduate course from the said merit lists only.

(iv) The seat matrix for admission in the Government, Government-aided Institutions and Private Institutions shall be fifteen per cent. for the all India quota and eighty-five per cent. for the States and Union territories quota.

(v) The designated authority for counseling for all admission to under-graduate course in all Ayurveda educational institutions in the States and Union territories including institutions established by the State Government, University, Deemed University, Trust, Society, Minority Institution, Corporation or Company shall be the respective State or Union territory in accordance with the relevant rules and regulations of the concerned State or Union territory Government, as the case may be.

(vi) The counseling for all admission to B.S.M.S Course for seats under all India quota as well as for all Siddha educational institutions established by the Central Government shall be conducted by the authority designated by the Central Government.

(vii) No candidate who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks as specified above shall be admitted to under-graduate course in the said academic year.

- (viii) No authority or institution shall admit any candidate to the under-graduate course in contravention of the criteria or procedure as laid down by these regulations in respect of admissions and any candidate admitted in contravention of the said criteria or procedure shall be discharged by the Central Council forthwith.
- (ix) The authority or institution which grants admission to any student in contravention of the aforesaid criteria or procedure shall be liable to face action in terms of the provisions of the Act.
- (e) Candidate must have passed Tamil as one of the subjects in the 10<sup>th</sup> Standard or in Higher Secondary course.
- (f) Candidates who are not covered under clause (e) shall have to study Tamil as a subject during the First Professional course.
- (g) For foreign national candidate any other equivalent qualification to be approved by the Central Government may be allowed and clause (d) shall not be applicable for said foreign national candidate.”.
4. In the said regulations, in Schedule-III, in regulation 2, for clause (A), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—
- “(A) Admission to KamileTib-O-Jarahat course: The eligibility to seek admission in KamileTib-O-Jarahat (Bachelor of Unani Medicine and Surgery- B.U.M.S.) course shall be as under:-
- (a) The candidate must have passed intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent examination recognised by the concerned State Government and Education Board with subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and must have obtained minimum fifty per cent. marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the aforesaid qualifying examination in the case of general category and forty per cent. marks in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes:
- Provided that the candidate must have passed the 10<sup>th</sup> standard with Urdu or Arabic or Persian language as a subject, or clear the test of Urdu of 10<sup>th</sup> Standard (wherever there is provision to conduct of such test) in the entrance examination conducted by the University or Board or registered Society or Association authorised by the Government to conduct such examination.
- (b) In respect of persons with disability candidate specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum qualifying marks in the said qualifying examination in Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be forty-five per cent. in the case of general category and forty per cent. in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.
- (c) No candidate shall be admitted to B.U.M.S Degree Course unless he has attained the age of seventeen years on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of his admission in the first year of the course and not more than of twenty-five years on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of admission in the first year of the course:
- Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed by five years in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes and physically handicapped candidates.
- (d) (i) There shall be a uniform entrance examination for all medical institutions at the under-graduate level, namely the National Eligibility Entrance Test (NEET) for admission to under-graduate course in each academic year and shall be conducted by an authority designated by the Central Government:
- Provided that the NEET shall not be applicable to Pre-Tib candidates and ten per cent. seats shall be reserved for Pre-Tib candidates.
- (ii) In order to be eligible for admission to under-graduate course for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in the ‘National Eligibility Entrance Test for under-graduate course’ held for the said academic year:
- Provided that in respect of-
- (I) candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 40<sup>th</sup> percentile;
- (II) candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45<sup>th</sup> percentile in the case of general category and 40<sup>th</sup> percentile in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.
- Explanation.**—The percentile shall be determined on the basis of highest marks secured in the all India common merit list in the National Eligibility Entrance Test for under-graduate courses:
- Provided further that when sufficient number of candidates in the respective categories fail to secure minimum marks in the National Eligibility Entrance Test, as specified above, held for any academic year for admission to under-graduate courses, the Central Government in consultation with the Central Council may at its discretion lower the minimum marks required for admission to under-graduate course for candidates belonging to

respective categories and marks so lowered by the Central Government shall be applicable for that academic year only.

(iii) An all India common merit list as well as State-wise merit list of the eligible candidates shall be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the National Eligibility Entrance Test and the candidates, within the respective categories, shall be admitted to under-graduate course from the said merit lists only.

(iv) The seat matrix for admission in the Government, Government-aided Institutions and Private Institutions shall be fifteen per cent. for the all India quota and eighty-five per cent. for the States and Union territories quota.

(v) The designated authority for counseling for all admission to under-graduate course in all Ayurveda educational institutions in the States and Union territories including institutions established by the State Government, University, Deemed University, Trust, Society, Minority Institution, Corporation or Company shall be the respective State or Union territory in accordance with the relevant rules and regulations of the concerned State or Union territory Government, as the case may be.

(vi) The counseling for all admission to B.U.M.S Course for seats under all India quota as well as for all Unani educational institutions established by the Central Government shall be conducted by the authority designated by the Central Government.

(vii) No candidate who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks as specified above shall be admitted to under-graduate course in the said academic year.

(viii) No authority or institution shall admit any candidate to the under-graduate course in contravention of the criteria or procedure as laid down by these regulations in respect of admissions and any candidate admitted in contravention of the said criteria or procedure shall be discharged by the Central Council forthwith.

(ix) The authority or institution which grants admission to any student in contravention of the aforesaid criteria or procedure shall be liable to face action in terms of the provisions of the Act.

(e) For foreign national candidates any other equivalent qualification to be approved by the Central Government maybe allowed and clause (d) shall not be applicable for said foreign national candidates or the Pre-Tib examination of one-year duration.”

I am directed to invite your attention to the Punjab Government Circular Letter No.1/3/95-3PP II/2043, dated 29/1/1996 vide which the instructions were issued regarding simplification of procedure for obtaining the certificate of Domicile for purposes of admission to educational institutions (including technical/medical institution). The matter has been reconsidered in the light of judgement delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Dr. Pradeep Jain Vs. Union of India and others reported as AIR 1984-SC-4121 wherein it was held that instead of the word 'Domicile' the word 'Residence' be used in the instructions issued by the State Government on the subject. Accordingly, it has been decided by the Government to revise the Government instructions referred to above as under:

Subject: Issuance of certificate for the purpose of seeking admission to various educational/technical/professional institutions in the state and also for employment.

Sir,

It has been brought to the notice of Government that educational authorities and institutions prescribe various certificates regarding residence, SC/BC category and backward area etc. to be furnished by the students/candidates with the applications forms for entrance examinations or employment in the formats and by the authorities different from those prescribed by the Government departments. Cases have also been reported where the authorities concerned insist on retaining original certificates and refuse to accept the attested photo copies of the certificates. All this results in harassment and panic among the students/candidates and their parents/guardian, since they have to apply with such certificates to more than one authorities simultaneously and within a limited period. The lists of certificates required at the time of applying for CET/PMET/PMT and PAU are enclosed by way of illustration.

2. In order to overcome the difficulty mentioned above, it has been decided by the Government that following procedure has been decided by the Government that the following procedure shall be followed meticulously by all the educational and other authorities concerned:-

- i) Certificates issued in the format and by the authorities prescribed by the Government Departments shall be accepted as valid by all educational institutions and other authorities.
- ii) Where a number of authorities have been authorized to issue the certificates there shall be no insistence on issue of a certificate by any particular authority or by the highest authority indicated in the format.
- iii)(a) In case of entrance examinations, no certificate should be called for in the first instance alongwith the application form. It will be sufficient for the candidate seeking admission or other facility to indicate in the application form whether he/she belongs to any particular category entitling him/her to certain concessions or facility. Requisite certificates may be obtained only from the selected/wait listed candidates.
- iii)(b) To further simplify the procedure attested copies of the certificates only shall be retained and original certificates if required to be produced at the time of interview shall be returned immediately, thereafter.
- iv) Parents/guardian or candidates can also obtain SC certificates from the Head of the institution where the candidates has studied if the proof is available in the school records.
- v) The persons who are employed in Government of India or any other State Government are to be treated at par with the employees of the Government of Punjab in the matter of issue of Scheduled Caste certificate provided relevant Scheduled Caste certificate exists in their service record. The Scheduled Caste certificate in such will be issued by the respective Heads of Departments in the Proforma below:-
